THEMES

- Practice & Procedure - Insights into Civil Procedure, Criminal Procedure, Evidence Law, and Litigation Practice
- ADR & Dispute Resolution - Exploring Arbitration, Mediation, Negotiation, and Alternative Dispute Mechanisms

Please note that the above themes are only indicative and not exhaustive, and there is no strict requirement that submissions must fall strictly within these categories. All submissions must be analytical in nature rather than merely descriptive.





Categories of the Submissions

- **Analytical Essays**
(1500–2000 words)
In-depth research and detailed analysis of legal issues
- **Case Comments / Legislative Notes**
(1200–1500 words)
Focused analysis of judgments or legal developments
- **Opinion Pieces**
(800–1200 words)
Short insights on current legal issues and debates

Formatting Guidelines

- The text must follow these formatting guidelines: Font – Times New Roman; Font Size – 12; Line Spacing – 1.5; Paragraph Spacing – 6 pt before and after.
- All references should preferably be provided through hyperlinks embedded within the body of the text. Endnotes should be used only in cases where hyperlinks are not available or applicable in **Bluebook (22nd edition)** citation style.
- Endnotes must be in Times New Roman, Font Size – 10, with single line spacing.
- The title must be bold and underlined, written in sentence case (not in all caps or small caps). Headings: Heading 2 must be bold, and Heading 3 must be underlined.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- All submissions must be original and unpublished. A plagiarism report (Turnitin or similar) must be submitted with a similarity index not exceeding 15% (excluding references and properly cited quotations).
- Submissions must be in .doc/.docx format only and sent via email to **editorialboardfairlexfairlex@gmail.com** with the subject line: with the subject line: "Title of the Blog".
- The submission email must include author name, designation/year of study, institutional affiliation, email ID, and contact number.
- Submissions are accepted on a rolling basis throughout the year. Authors may submit their work at any time for consideration.
